- Post application

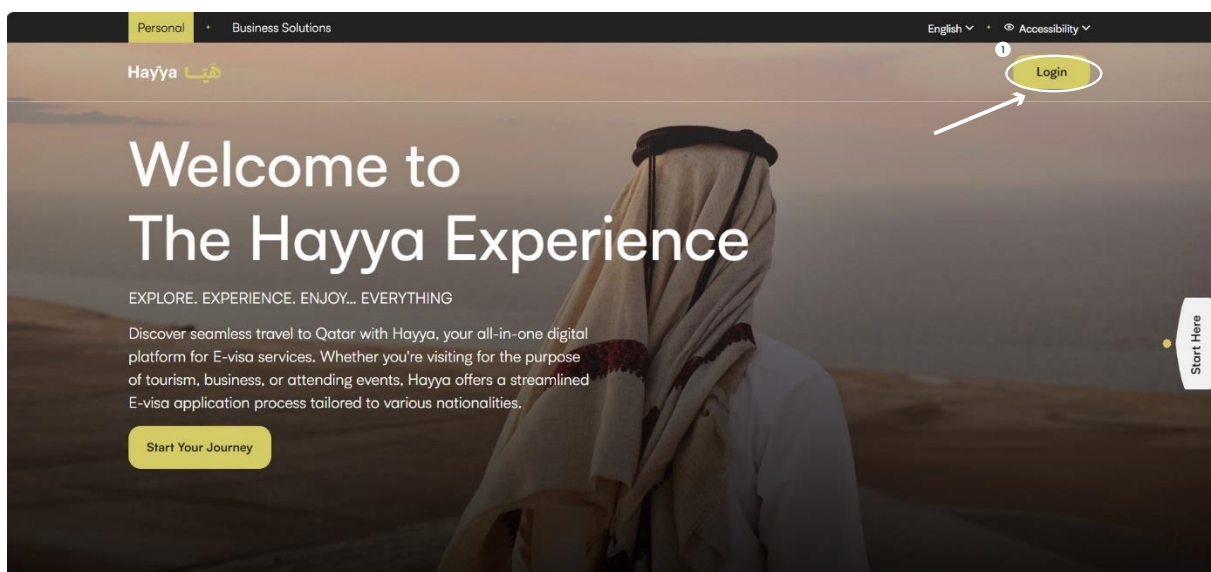
4. Steps

Below table outlines the steps and procedures to apply for Conference and Events Visa (B) on B2C.

4.1 Logging In:

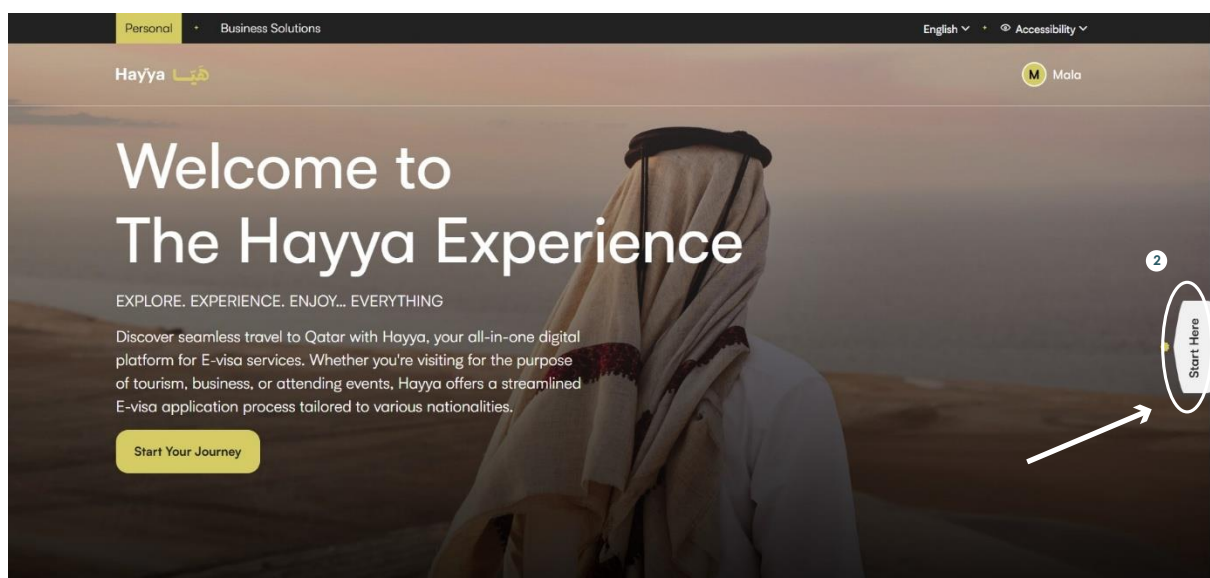
1- Log in to hayya.qa

The Applicant can login from the home screen by clicking on the **Login** button



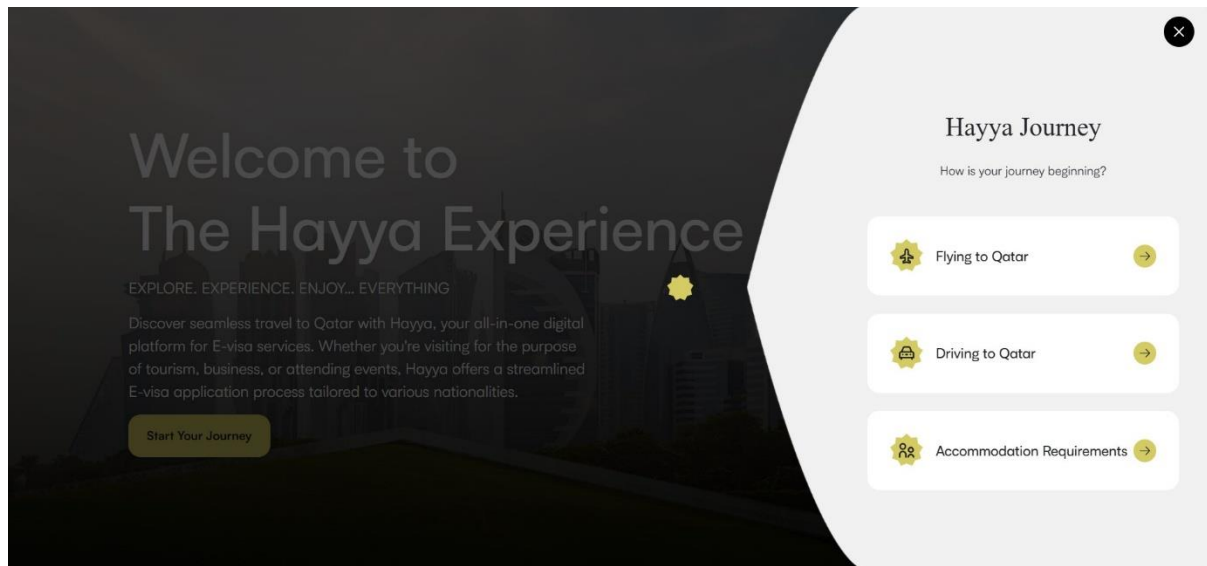
- 2- The Applicant can login using the available options or sign up if they do not yet have an account.

- 3- After logging in, the applicant will reach the landing page below. Click on the **"Start here"** button to begin the process of applying for the preferred Hayya category.

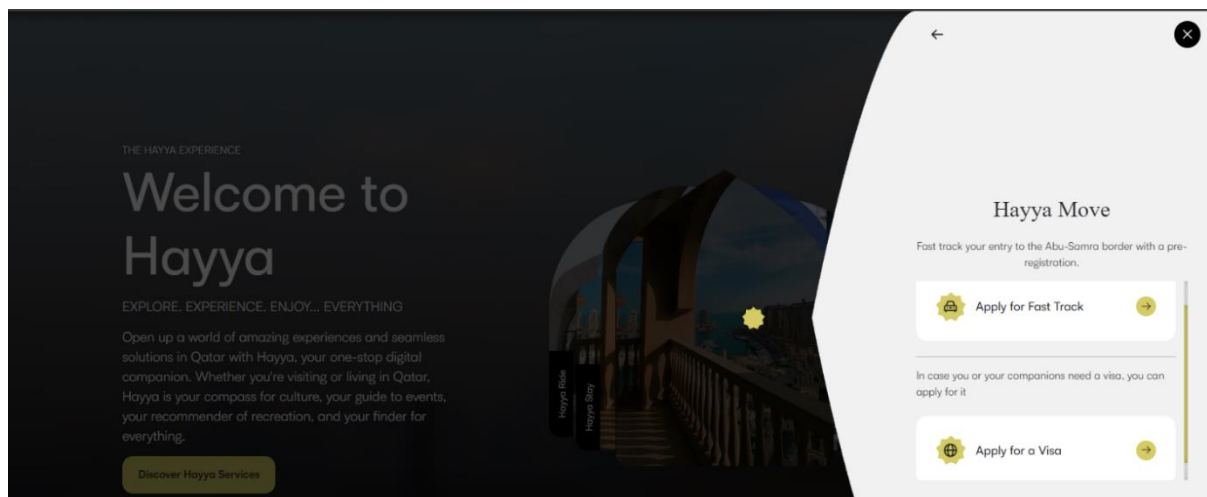


4.1.1 Hayya Journey

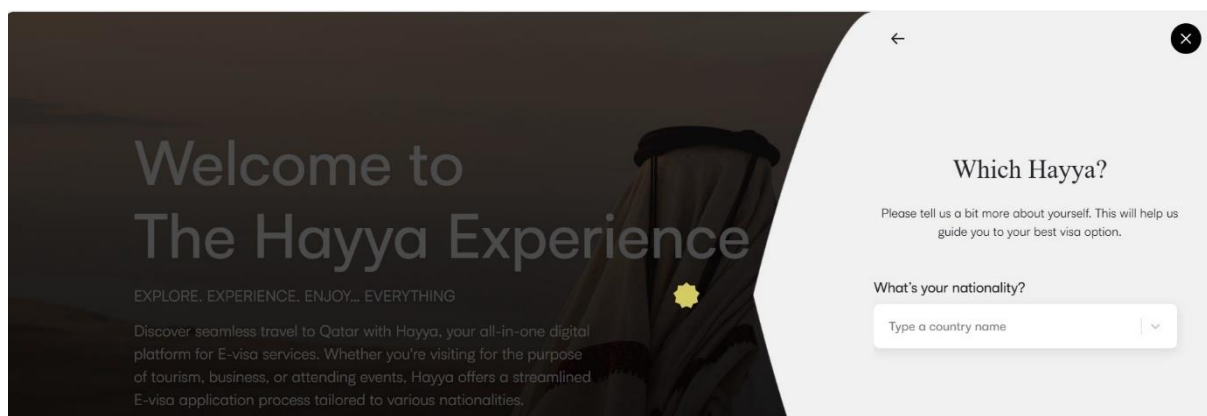
1- Begin the Hayya Journey by choosing the mode of entering the country.



2- If the applicant chose “**Driving to Qatar**” as the mode of entering Qatar, they can click on “**Apply for a Visa**” to proceed applying for the visa.



3- If the applicant chose “**Flying to Qatar**”, then they have to provide the below information.



4- After selecting the nationality, choose “**Yes**” if you have a voucher. And tap on “**Confirm**” button to proceed.

4.1.3 Personal Information:

1- Tap on “**Browse for picture**”. Acknowledge the photo guidelines and upload your desired photo.



2- Upload your document copy.

3- Select the appropriate Passport type and fill the Arabic name as mentioned in the passport (if required).

4- Fill in all contact information, Phone number, Emergency Contact Name and Emergency Contact Number and Click on "**Validate your ID**" to proceed.

5- Upon validating your ID, the **"Next"** button will be enabled. Click on **"Next"** to proceed to the next section of the application.

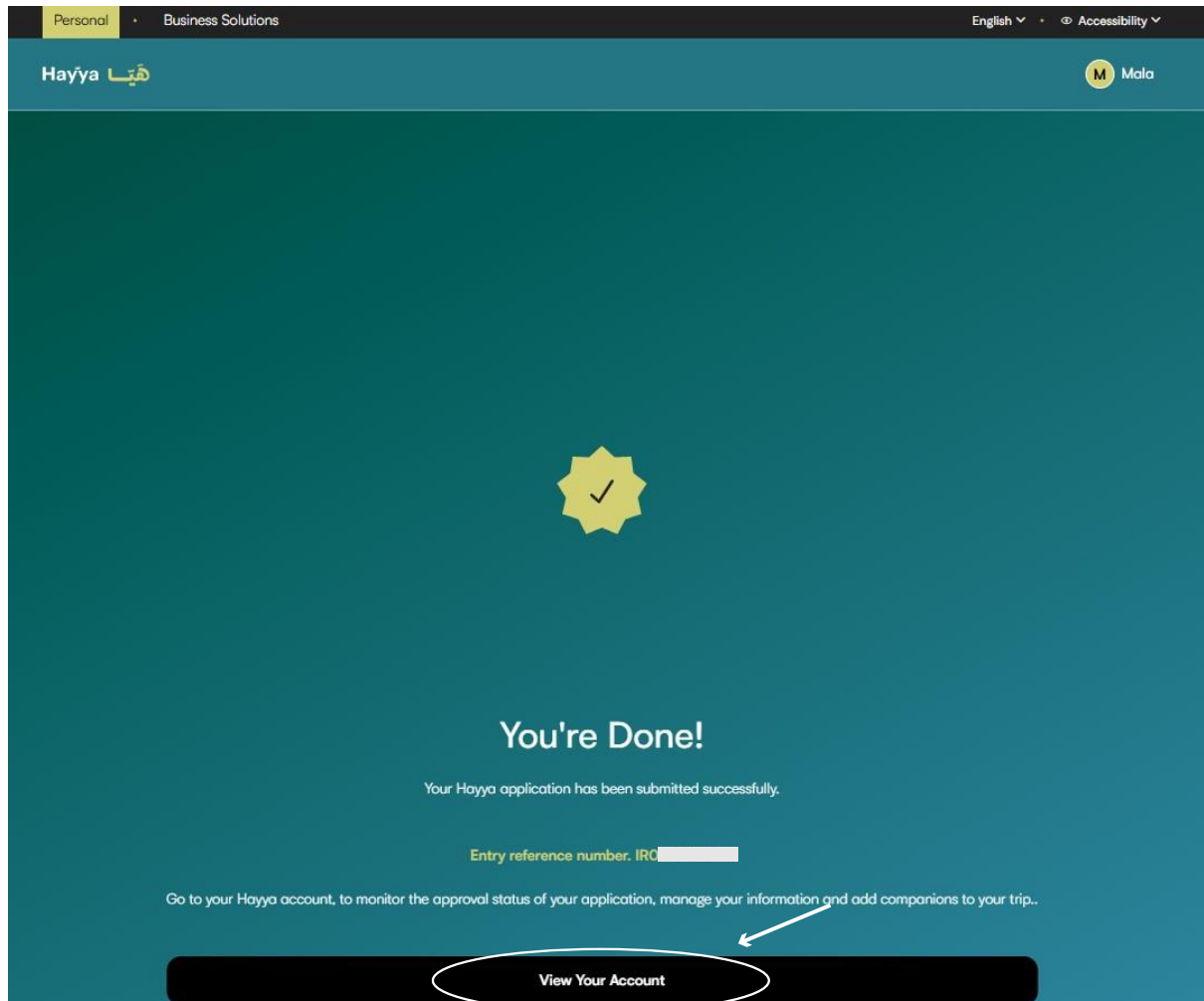
